Than I have joined as the EAP delegate to the **ESWI** (European Scientific Working group on Influenza) the last meetings in May and June, where I represent the European pediatricians : The aim of the ESWI meeting is to bring together all influenza stakeholder organizations and to provide them with a platform to discuss influenza prevention strategies, to exchange good practices and to initiate concrete actions.

The conferences have a focus on science. In addition, government representatives and opinion leaders in health care are invited to the meeting to attend separate, tailor-made programme-tracks. After all, the fight against the impact of influenza can only be won when all parties involved are well informed and ready to collaborate.

It should be a MUST in the future **to provide training opportunities** not only for students but also for graduates and also for CME (the **Austrian University Trainings- Program**: Prof Ursula Kunze has worked out an University lectures program by module system with mandatory immunisation / vaccination – questions at the final examination).

Than I want to tell you that I have become the chair together with Elke for the **common trunk training program** / EAP to get finally a handsome reasonable brochure.

In Austria we have to work on a **new specialist training program** which is a demand of the health minister.
