The humanitarian disaster unfolding in Gaza is heartbreaking.

The lives and futures of hundreds of thousands of children are at risk.

As pediatricians devoted to healing and protecting children, we cannot remain silent while children are dying from starvation and the lack of access to medical care.

We cannot accept that all civilian infrastructure, including hospitals and schools, is destroyed and that access to food, clean water, and essential healthcare is systematically denied.

We demand immediate and large-scale access for humanitarian organizations to distribute lifesaving food, water, and medicine in the face of mass starvation.

We ask for the establishment of medical corridors to evacuate the wounded and that our countries accept to treat patients in need of urgent medical care.

Finally, we ask for the release of all Israeli hostages. International medical agencies should visit them and guarantee their human rights.

We would also like to share with you the following statements by our partner organizations. The lives and futures of hundreds of thousands of children are at stake. Silence is not neutrality—it is complicity.
