

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

**International Society for Social Pediatrics and Child Health and
the European Confederation for Primary Care Paediatricians**

Whereas the International Society for Social Pediatrics and Child Health (ISSOP) and the European Confederation for Primary Care Paediatricians (Parties) represent health professionals committed to the global health and wellbeing of children; and

Whereas Parties pursue this commitment through education, research and child advocacy in the domains of clinical care, systems development and policy generation; and

Whereas Parties' mutual organizational missions, goals, objectives and work can be advanced and enhanced through a formal partnership and sustained collaboration; and

Whereas Parties understand and are committed to voluntary participation in all aspects of this partnerships and collaboration;

Therefore, be it resolved that Parties will establish a formal partnership to enhance and advance their respective missions to improve the global health and well-being of children and youth, such that:

This Memorandum of Understanding will establish the partnership (Partnership) between Parties;

Liaison Officers/Delegates of each Organization may participate in the meeting of the other organization at their own expense; and

Publications, educational materials, announcements emanating from either Party may be distributed by each organization on voluntary basis to its own members; and

Both Parties' members will be offered to be engaged in the respective work of the Parties; and

Opportunities may be sought for collaboration on endeavors in all acceptable domains of the Parties' work; and


Joint educational meetings, webinars and other forms of medical education may be developed;

Joint research and evaluation initiatives may be established; and

Joint child advocacy and policy initiatives may be pursued; and Parties agree to periodic virtual meetings to assess the Partnership's function and plan for future collaboration.
