

COVID-19-situation in Germany / short summary

Numbers:

- German population: 83 100 000 inhabitants
- 16 federal states
- Total number of currently infected and healed persons: 2 328 447
- Dead people due to or in connection with COVID : 64 742
- Current incidence: 60 / 100 000 (range of states: 51-99/ 100 000)
- Start of COVID-19 vaccination: 26.12.2020
- Total number of persons who received one dose of COVID-19 vaccine:
2 635 673 (3,2% of the population)
- Total number of persons who received two doses of COVID-19 vaccine:
1 331 573 (1,6% of the population)

Second lockdown: 17.12.2020 – 07.03.2021

School/kindergarten:

On 15.02.2021 all paediatric societies and the Robert-Koch-Institut (RKI) consented to an arrangement concerning reopening of schools (closed since 17.12.2020)

The 16 federal states pursue different strategies, including reopening schools and kindergarten. Some states announce the reopening for 15.02.21, further 10 states will reopen kindergarten, primary schools (1-4 class) and exam classes on 22.02.2021.

In NRW schoolteacher can get a rapid antigen-test every week. When they do in-classroom teaching they may get this test twice a week.

Testing for pupils differ from state to state. Gargling tests are not yet licensed.

No COVID-vaccination for children under the age of 18 yrs.
